Welcome to City Space, a tranquil hideaway above the bustling Singapore. Enjoy the wonderful view and relax to our live music, but most of all, appreciate the fine cocktails prepared with care and attention from our Bartenders.

At heart we are a classic bar, taking inspiration from the 1800s when cocktails were the 'new thing'. This was when drinks were crafted with the finest ingredients and freshest produce and were treated as cutting edge epicurean delights to be celebrated and respected.

We take our inspiration from Professor Jerry Thomas, the most famous Bartender of the 1800s and his book, the first cocktail book ever penned, Bartenders Guide: How to Mix Drinks in 1862.

Following his words, we use fresh ingredients, our citrus juices are pressed by hand, mint from our herb garden and syrups are made inhouse. Our premium selection of spirits and liqueurs are sought after and hard to find.

We fill our glasses with double frozen ice. This ensures a colder, crisper drink that will not dilute and leave you with a watery cocktail. More ice equals better, not lesser, drinks.

For our luxury spirits, should you ask for ice, we use either handcarved cubes or spheres.

We keep our selection small to concentrate on presenting you our favourite cocktails of the season, not forgetting vintage and classics which we sometimes twist and tweak for a modern or intriguing variation.

However, if you have a pandering for other drinks not listed, simply engage one of our Bartenders and we shall do our best to mix it for you.

Where you see two prices listed, the latter is one you enjoy during our happy hour period from 5pm until 8pm, daily.

We also add **passionfruit** for extra fruitiness as done by locals in Peru. If you would prefer without the fruit, just let us know...

#### Long Island Iced Tea

This drink has traveled far and wide from its incarnation back in **Long Island** in the 70s. We hope you like our version which has some added **sophistication** and **depth.** 

The famous **five white spirits** blended with **TWG Earl Grey Buddha Tea**, fresh **lemon** and **Coca-Cola**.

## Whisky Sour

**TWG Chamomile Tea**-infused **Maker's Mark Bourbon** with handpressed **lemon** juice, **simple** syrup and The Bitter Truth **Orange Bitters**.

Our infusion of **Chamomile** gently softens the **Bourbon** and adds a delicate floral bouquet while the syrup melds the flavours together.

The original and best Bond martini cocktail. From Casino Royale and said to have been created by author Ian Flemings' bartender in 1950. 'Three parts **gin**, one measure of **vodka** and half a measure of **Kina Lillet**. Shake until ice cold and serve in a deep champagne goblet with a large thin slice of **lemon peel**.'

#### Mai Tai Original Recipe

"I took down a bottle of (Flor de Cana 7) rum. I took a fresh lime, added some orange curacao, a dash of Rock Candy Syrup, and a dollop of French Orgeat. Half the lime shell went in for color ... I stuck in a branch of fresh mint and gave two of them to friends from Tahiti. Carrie took one sip and said, "Mai Tai - Roa Ae". In Tahitian this means "Out of This World - The Best". Well, that was that. I named the drink 'Mai Tai'." By Victor 'Trader Vic' Bergeron

#### Dark & Stormy

A simple mix **Goslings Black Seal** Rum with hand pressed **lime** juice and spicy **Ginger Beer** with a touch of **Aromatic** Bitters for depth. The official cocktail of Bermuda and easily one of the most quaffable.

#### Vintage Recreations

Pegu Club

\$20/15

**Pegu** Club was a **Gentlemen's** club located in Yangon, Burma. It was built in the late 1880s and was one of the most famous gentlemen's clubs in Southeast Asia, on par with the Royal Selangor Club of Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia and **Tanglin** Club in Singapore. This was their signature.

We shake **Gordon's Gin** with **Cointreau** and **lime** and serve straight up with **Angostura Aromatic Bitters** and The Bitter Truth **Orange Bitters**.

#### Manhattan & Martinez

\$25/15

The Manhattan is undoubtedly one of the greatest cocktails ever invented. Our version is an intriguing and unforgettable mix of Maker's Mark Bourbon with rare Carpano Antica Formula Vermouth, dry Maraschino liqueur and piquant orange bitters.

The Martinez uses **Tanqueray Gin in place of the Whisky** and is the original version of what evolved into the **Dry Martini**.

Sazerac

\$30/20

The **Sazerac** is one of the oldest known cocktails. The original drink is based on a combination of Cognac and bitters created by Antoine Peychaud in the 1830s.

We use **Hennessy Cognac** with **La Fee Parisienne Absinthe**, brown **sugar**, **Bitter Truth Creole Bitters** and **lemon peel** served with a hand-carved Fiji ice chunk.

#### Corpse Reviver Number 2

\$22/15

Corpse Revivers were a category of drinks that were imbibed as hangover cures. It was stated that 'more than four in swift succession will unrivive the corpse!'

Miller's Gin, Cointreau and Lillet Blanc shaken with Absinthe and fresh lemon juice.

#### Straits Sling

\$22/15

Created in 1911 by Ngiam Tong Boom at the Raffles Hotel in Singapore, this is the original rendition of the now **World Famous Singapore Sling** forgotten in the 30s, and later rediscovered.

It is the perfect, elegant sundowner; long and refreshing, combining **London Dry Gin** with **Kirsch Eaux de Vie, herbal Benedictine liqueur** and lightly spiced **ginger ale**.

#### The Avenue

A vintage cocktail from the **Café Royal Cocktail Book 1922** credited to W. G. Crompton. This is a fruity, rich and aromatic cocktail that deserves to be pulled back to the modern age.

**Bourbon** and **Calvados** with **passionfruit**, homemade **grenadine** for sweetness and **orange flower water** for aroma.

#### Martinis
