USE THESE SNAP-HAPPY TIPS!

- 1. Don't photograph straight on**
Tilt your head slightly with your best side to the camera for a universally flattering selfie angle.
- 2. Learn from the pros**
A simple travel photography pro tip is to look for patterns, which are highly photogenic. Repetitions of shapes, colours, and lines increase visual interest.
- 3. Smile like a model**
Want to pull off a smize? Learn from the supermodels: squint, relax your lips and eyebrows, then pretend a string is pulling your face up from above.
