The magnificent QVB houses over 180 boutiques from fashion to homewares and a variety of dining options. The vintage elevator makes for a great nostalgic snap!



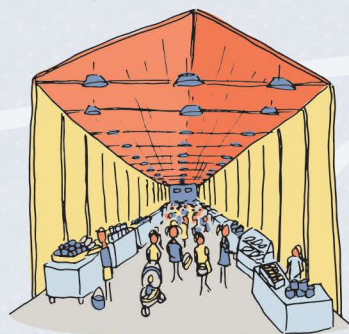
## Sydney Tower

### USE THESE SNAP-HAPPY TIPS!

- 1. Proportion is everything!**  
Use people in landscapes to create a sense of scale and place. This is particularly useful when trying to convey how grand or large a structure is.
- 2. Night photography 101**  
Shooting at night? Use the light from another smartphone to illuminate your face by positioning it back-to-back with your camera phone.
- 3. Avoid the red-eye effect**  
Look at bright (preferably natural) light just before a selfie to constrict pupils and minimise the dreaded red eye.
